FIL Industries Spearheads Construction of Record Breaking Dehradun Mussoorie Ropeway

Mussoorie Sky Car Company, a consortium led by FIL Industries and comprising of POMA SAS France and SRM Engineering LLP, has commenced work on India's longest ropeway system at a length over 5.5 km connecting the twin cities of Dehradun and Mussoorie. The Rs 300 crore mono-cable ropeway project that will connect Dehradun-Mussoorie will be ready by September 2026.

The ropeway will cut down the 33 kms driving distance between Dehradun to and Mussoorie, which can take from 1.5 to 3 hours depending on traffic, to a mere 15 minutes.

For the first time in India, this ropeway will have 10-seater cabins. These enclosed, fully ventilated, glazed, automatic opening and closing-door cabins will initially have the capacity to carry upto 1300 passengers-per-hour-per-direction. The all-weather ropeway that will operate throughout the year, come rain or snow, will considerably reduce traffic congestion in the region, especially during peak festive seasons for locals and tourists. This is the first ropeway in India which is being built both for tourism purposes as well as for urban mobility between the two cities in Uttarakhand.

"We are excited to launch this mega ropeway project in Uttarakhand, FIL Industries' second ropeway project in India, after our running Skyview by Empyrean project in Patnitop, Jammu. Once ready, it will not only provide a source of employment and bring in revenue to the state; it will also attract tourists from across the world, contributing considerably to the state GDP," said Owais Altaf Syed, group director, FIL Industries.

The 22-acre Skyview by Empyrean Mountain harbour blends premium hospitality, adventure, nature, and luxury. It is also known as a 'green gondola' revolutionized travel between Sanget Valley and Patnitop, cutting road travel time by over an hour and significantly reducing vehicular pollution.
